As we approach the season of Lent, with Ash Wednesday on February 22nd, we enter into a time that reflects Jesus' 40 days in the wilderness. We will be exploring Lent through themes from, Kate Bowler's book "The Lives We Actually Have," with her Lenten series, "Bless the Lent we Actually Have."

Here is how she describes this series:

"Lent is our annual rehearsal of the cosmic moment when Jesus' suffering and death and resurrection will change how we experience death. Death will not be the defining truth about us. Someday we will be freed from the gorgeous and horrible limitations of our human lives, and we will live forever with God (which is VERY DIFFICULT FOR ME TO IM-AGINE. But it's the truth.). But first Jesus suffers and dies. We walk with him. And he walks with us. Jesus will walk with us through whatever kind of Lenten day you are having. The lovely one. The garbage one. The one that barely seems like it counted at all. As we toggle through every kind of emotion—boredom, devastation, happiness, irritation—we want to say: bless this Lent."

This book of blessings invites the language of the beatitudes such as, "Blessed are those who are fragile." Our Liturgical Arts team is hard at work putting together an outdoor cross display that will feature the words of the series as well as flowers created from recycled items. Indoors they will be bringing in the imagery of wilderness and connecting them with elements of recycled and raw materials.




